

ELEMENTARY – SET 1 Say it in Indonesian.

1. There are several fruit trees behind the house.

Ada beberapa pohon buah di belakang rumah.

2. This TV costs \$1,450.

Harga televisi [or: TV] ini \$1.450. [= “seribu empat ratus lima puluh dolar”]

[Alternatively: “Televisi ini (,) harganya \$1.450.”]

3. I don’t know when that train leaves.

Saya tidak tahu kapan kereta api itu berangkat.

4. What time do you wake up?

Jam berapa kamu bangun / bangun tidur? [Or: Kamu bangun / bangun tidur jam berapa?]

5. Next month they will travel to Indonesia.

Bulan depan mereka akan berjalan ke Indonesia.

6. In this town, autumn is the most beautiful season.

Di kota ini, musim gugur adalah musim (yang) paling indah [or ‘terindah’]

7. If you’re hungry we can eat now.

Kalau (kamu) sudah lapar kita bisa makan sekarang.

8. Have you ever seen a ghost?

Apakah kamu pernah melihat hantu?

9. Today is my birthday.

Hari ini saya berulang tahun. [Or: ‘Hari ini (adalah) ulang tahun saya’]

10. Your house is really close to the shopping centre.

Rumah kamu sangat dekat dengan pusat belanja.

11. He doesn’t want to work in an office any more.

Dia tidak ingin lagi bekerja [or: ‘ingin bekerja lagi’] di kantor.

12. She isn't as tall as her older or younger siblings.

Dia tidak setinggi kakak atau adiknya.

13. What are they looking for?

Mereka mencari apa? [or 'Apa yang mereka cari?', i.e., 'What is it that is looked-for by them?']

14. There are good people and bad / wicked people everywhere.

Ada orang baik dan orang jahat di mana-mana.

15. I like watching action films and comedies.

Saya suka menonton film aksi dan film komedi / film lucu.

16. Why do you want to work in this company?

Mengapa Anda ingin bekerja di perusahaan itu?

17. I'm not so good at cooking yet.

Saya belum begitu [or: 'terlalu'] pandai memasak.

18. I only know a little about the history of Indonesia.

Saya hanya tahu sedikit tentang sejarah Indonesia.

19. She missed the bus to Bukittinggi.

Dia ketinggalan bus ke Bukittinggi. ['ketinggalan [x]' means 'to be left behind by [x]']

20. How old is your younger sibling?

Berapa umur adik kamu [or: 'adikmu']?
